The Presbytery of Lake Huron will hold its stated meeting on **Tuesday, December 6, 2022, starting at 9:30 AM**. This will be a **hybrid meeting** with the ability to be in-person or by Zoom. Our host congregation is Westminster Presbyterian Church, 103 E. The last element will be an update on the themes from our feedback and next steps.

Then just before lunch, we will install the Moderator and Vice-Moderator for 2023.

For business, as mentioned, we will vote on the revised "Church Discipline" amendment to the Book of Order. Also, we will elect the nominees for our Presbytery Committees and Commissions, approve the 2023 budget, and several additional items.
