#### PRESBYTERY OF LAKE HURON

Stated Meeting – June 7, 2022

The Presbytery of Lake Huron was called to order with prayer by the Moderator, the Rev. Glenn Grant, at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, and was held via Zoom and inperson at Alma College, Alma, Michigan.

The roll was taken, and the moderator announced that a quorum was present. [ATTACHMENT A]

A welcome by Alma College President, Jeff Abernathy, was given.

A welcoming of new minister member, Kate Morritauk, was given. She was recently called to serve as Pastor of Flint-Trinity United.

MOTION WAS SUSTAINED to seat the following as a Corresponding Member: The Rev. Kate Morritauk (Salem).

An introduction of new commissioners was given.

MOTION WAS SUSTAINED to adopt the docket.

A presentation by Cathy Chang, Mission Co-Worker in the Philippines, was given via Zoom.

A short **BREAK** was taken prior to worship.

**WORSHIP** included a sermon by Alma College student, Justice Cuddie. The **OFFERING** taken will be given to I.G.N.I.T.E (Inmate, Growth, Naturally and Intentionally Through Education) program of Genesee County.

A short **BREAK** was taken prior to the breakout discussions.

The Moderator reconvened the presbytery.

Round table and breakout room discussions were held. Questions encouraged attendees to give their thoughts on the future of the presbytery, a useful structure and what churches need most for the presbytery.

**COMMISSIONING OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY COMMISSIONERS** the Rev. Lindsey Carnes and Elder Byungil Ahn took place.

Katrina Pekich-Bundy asked for volunteers to help provide pastoral care for General Assembly commissioners.

Adjourned for lunch following prayer by Katrina Pekich-Bundy.

Reconvened by the Moderator.

The Vice Moderator assumed the chair.

The **PRESBYTERY COUNCIL** report was given by Glenn Grant. The Financial Secretary, Jessica Schira, presented the 2021 Year End Financial Report. [ATTACHMENT B]

The Presbytery Council presented the following items for information:

- 1. The Personnel Team has updated and approved job descriptions for the Administrative Assistant/Office Manager, Communications Manager/Recording Clerk and Financial Secretary positions at the Presbytery Office.
- 2. Two small groups, consisting of persons in the Presbytery who were interested in discussing their thoughts on the Executive Presbyter position, met on April 21, 2022 via Zoom meeting service. The small-group structured dialogues were facilitated by Devon Miller, Associate Director, Lombard Mennonite Peace Center (LMPC). Observations and recommendations from LMPC will be presented to Council in the near future. Funds from account #000-110-52002 (Non-Budgeted Expenditures) will be used to cover the approximately \$1,600 cost.
- 3. A listening session for Presbytery staff was held on May 4, 2022 facilitated by Devon Miller, Associate Director, Lombard Mennonite Peace Center. The session was designed to help staff work through the process. Funds from account #000-110-52002 (Non-Budgeted Expenditures) will be used to cover the approximately \$700 cost.
- 4. Approved donating \$2,000 to Michigan Nanum Presbyterian Church to help defray costs of updating their sound system. Approximate cost to update is \$28,000. The Presbytery uses their facilities several times a year. Funds from account #272012-Church Transformation and Growth (technology grant) were used to cover costs.
- 5. Approved a plan to re-size the Resource Center at the Presbytery Office. The plan includes advertising in the Bi-Weekly Brief that churches who are interested in the items may come and retrieve them. The items are available for pick-up during regular business hours through September 30, 2022 on a first come, first served basis. After that date, items not picked up will be given to area ministry or disposed of. Items that the Presbytery Office intends to keep will be placed on the bookshelves located in the entranceway to the office.

Michigan Nanum Presbyterian Church is currently using the room on a regular basis but needs additional shelf space. The Resource Center contains outdated books, DVD, VHS tapes and other media items that are no longer used.

- 6. Designated the June Presbytery Meeting offering be given to the I.G.N.I.T.E. (Inmate, Growth, Naturally and Intentionally Through Education) program of Genesee County.
- 7. Approved conducting regional listening sessions for the purpose of defining the future role of the Presbytery in relationship with its' congregations. The process will begin during the business portion of the June Presbytery meeting. Regional listening sessions will be held both in person and virtual. A minimum of two representations from each congregation will be asked to participate. Scheduling of these sessions will be announced in the near future. An invitation to participate will be placed in the May 18, 2022 edition of the Bi-Weekly Brief. Responses will be compiled by Glenn Grant. Listening sessions will be coordinated and moderated by Glenn Grant, Lindsey Carnes, Linda Kennan and Kathy Maurer.
- 8. Receive the report of the Financial Secretary of the 2021 Year End Financial Report of the Presbytery. [ATTACHMENT B]

The **COMMISSION ON MINISTRY AND MINISTRY PREPARATION** report was given by Linda Kennan. The **COMMITTEE ON PREPARATION** report was given by Robbie Carnes.

Inquirer Allison Muenzer spoke about her faith journey and answered questions from attendees.

MOTION WAS SUSTAINED to move Allison Muenzer to Candidate Under Care of the Presbytery.

Linda Kennan invited currently serving clergy and CREs to attend the Clergy Retreat being sponsored by COMMP this September at St. Francis Retreat Center.

The Commission on Ministry and Ministry Preparation reported that it took the following actions on behalf of presbytery:

- 1. Approved the Commission on Preparation for Ministry Handbook as the Operating Manual for the team.
- 2. Appointed Mary Ann Parker as Moderator of the May 1, 2022 congregational meeting at Flint-Trinity for the purpose of calling Kate Morritauk as their Pastor.
- 3. Appointed Linda Kennan as Moderator of a special congregational meeting of the Sandusky and Yale congregations on May 1, 2022.
- 4. Appointed Linda Kennan, John Tapley and Brant Piper to Moderator the June 19, 2022 congregational meetings of Kinde-First, Cass City-Fraser and Elkton-

Chandler for the purpose of calling the Rev. Christina Jensen as Pastor of the three congregations.

- 5. Appointed John Tapley as Moderator of the June 12, 2022 congregational meeting of Lapeer-First for the purpose of call the Rev. Hal Shafer as Pastor.
- 6. Approved a technology grant in the amount of \$2000 for Kinde-First.
- 7. Approved the budget for a clergy retreat to be held September 13-15, 2022 at the St. Francis Center in DeWitt, MI.
- 8. Approved the full-time Interim Pastor contract renewal between the Rev. Philomena Ofori-Nipaah and Saginaw-Second, effective June 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. Terms are as follows:

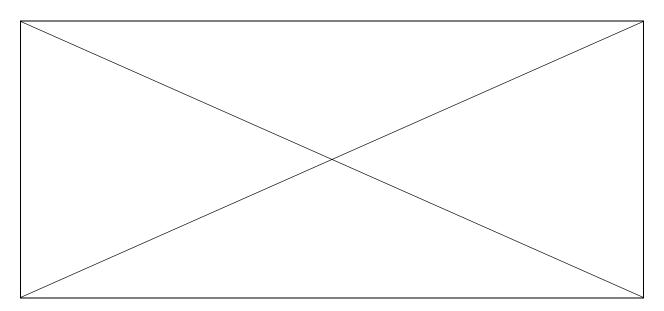

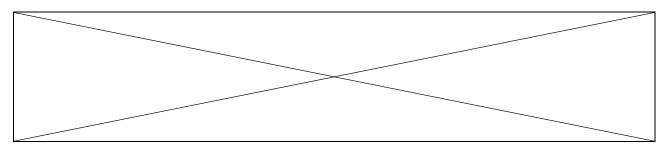

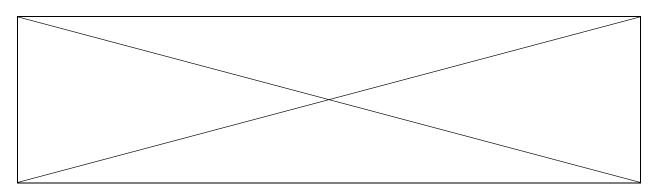
